**IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING**

**A. REGARDING YOUR PENSION SERVICE CREDIT**

Pension Service date is submitted for your records and should be considered for informational purposes only. If no amount is printed for Prior Service Period 1937 thru 1960, it means either that you had no qualifying credit during those years or that you have not submitted a record of your SAG earnings so that an amount of pension credit could be determined. The Current Service Period Credit has been developed from Employer Contribution Reports. This information does not mean that a pension will necessarily be paid or, if paid, that it will be based upon the amounts stated. Furthermore, ultimate payment of pension benefits will depend upon your meeting all of the eligibility requirements of the Pension Plan.

**B. REGARDING THIS STATEMENT OF YOUR EARNINGS UNDER SAG AGREEMENTS**

The statement on the reverse side hereof is a summary of your earnings as an Actor/Actress from employers in the Motion Picture Industry (including theatrical motion pictures, television motion pictures, television motion picture commercials, and industrial and educational motion pictures) who have signed Collective Bargaining Agreements with the Screen Actors Guild. Only those earnings that are required to be reported for pension purposes under SAG agreements are included in the statement. This statement of earnings will not necessarily agree with the W-2 Statement of Earnings you use for income tax purposes.

**C. THIS STATEMENT OF EARNINGS DOES NOT INCLUDE earnings you may have received as follows:**

1. Earnings under AFTRA, EQUITY, AGVA, or SEG Collective Bargaining Agreements are not included.
2. Residual payments for reruns of TV Commercials made prior to November 16, 1960 are not included.
3. Residual payments from reruns of TV Motion Pictures made prior to June 1, 1960 are not included.
4. Residual payments for reuse of Industrial and Educational Motion Pictures made prior to November 1, 1960 are not included.
5. Residual payments for television exhibition of Theatrical Motion Pictures made prior to January 31, 1966 are not included.
6. Theatrical Motion Pictures - The percentage shall be paid on the first \$200,000 for services rendered on and after July 1, 1983. For services rendered between October 6, 1980 and June 30, 1983, the percentage shall be paid on the first \$165,000. For services rendered between July 1 1977 and October 5, 1980, the percentage shall be paid on the first \$150,000. For services rendered prior to July 1, 1977, the percentage shall be paid on the first \$100,000. (Also applies to TV Motion Pictures released Theatrically.)
7. Payments for various penalties and allowances such as meal penalties, late calls, payments for rest period violations, traveling expense, lodging or living expenses, interest on delinquent payments, reimbursement for special hairdress or for wardrobe damage, or for the use of personal automobile or other equipment are not included.
8. Earnings for services in TV motion pictures are not included in excess of the ceilings as follows:

**D. REGARDING NOTIFICATION IN CASE OF ERROR**

The Screen Actors Guild-Producers Pension Plan office will presume that the Statement of Earnings on the reverse side hereof is correct and will become final for Pension Plan purposes unless notification of error is received in writing within 90 days of the postmarked date of this mailing.

In case of error notify SAG-Producers Pension Plan Contribution Dept., 3601 West Olive Avenue, P.O. Box 7830, Burbank, CA 91510-7830, in writing within 90 days. Please furnish detailed information with respect to name of employer, dates, place, and kind of employment (including name of production covered or product and other identification in case of TV Commercials) and earnings received. DO NOT include any earnings listed under "C" above. It is essential that you send copies of your pay stubs for the items that you believe to be missing or incorrectly reported to the Plans. Please provide us with a telephone number where you can be reached if we need further information.

**E. GENERAL**

The financial statements of the Screen Actors Guild-Producers Pension and Health Plans are audited annually by independent accountants and may be examined by Plan participants at the Burbank office of the Plans. Annual reports covering operations of the Plans are filed by the Pension and Health Plans with the various agencies as required by applicable State and Federal Laws. Copies of the audited financial statements and the annual reports may be examined at any of the Screen Actors Guild-Producers Pension and Health Plan offices.
