## QDRO OR COURT ORDER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

A Qualified Domestic Relations Order (QDRO) is a court order that creates or recognizes the existence of an individual's right, or assigns to such individual the right to receive all or a portion of a plan participant's benefits payable under a pension plan. In most cases the individual is an ex-spouse. Because the Screen Actors Guild-Producers Pension Plan is legally required to assign any or all of a participant's benefit to an individual named in a QDRO, the Plan has an interest in knowing whether an outstanding QDRO or other similar court order exists at the time the participant applies for their pension. Accordingly, if your benefits are subject to a QDRO or similar court order, or if you anticipate that a QDRO or similar court order will be issued with respect to your benefits during the coming year, please provide us with a copy of such document and/or notify the Plan office immediately.

If your benefits are not subject to a QDRO or similar court order and you do not anticipate that such a QDRO or similar court order will be issued with respect to your pension benefits in the coming year, please sign this document where indicated after you have read the following acknowledgement:

**I understand that the Screen Actors Guild-Producers Pension Plan is obligated to assign benefits to any individual named in a Qualified Domestic Relations Order (QDRO) or any other similar court order. To the best of my knowledge, there is no outstanding QDRO or similar court order, nor do I anticipate any such Order to be issued in the coming year and that it is my responsibility to contact the Plan if there is an Order.**
